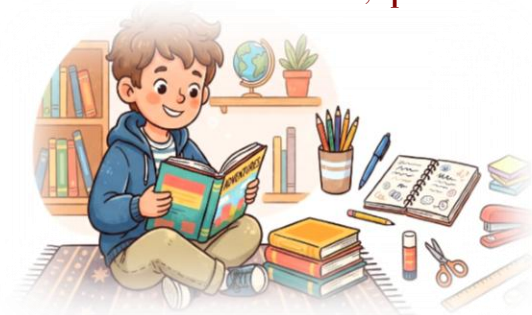


ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Class Room Sessions- April & May - 2026

Classroom sessions for children were conducted systematically in accordance with the planned lesson schedules. Each classroom session commenced with a welcome routine and Morning Prayer, creating a positive learning environment and preparing children for the day's activities. Planned learning experiences were carried out using age-appropriate teaching methods, including storytelling, rhymes, conversations, demonstrations, play-based activities, group work, and hands-on exploration.

The lesson plans covered a range of themes and concepts such as language development, literacy skills, numeracy skills, colours, shapes, environmental awareness, personal hygiene, and good habits.

Evaluation - I June-2026

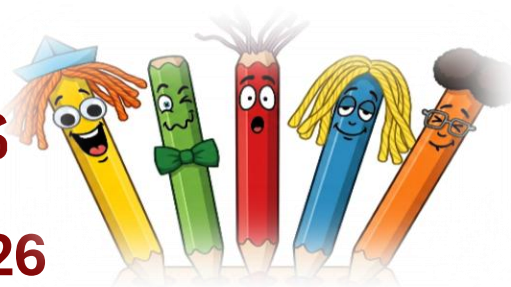
